

Section G16 Order of the Arrow High Adventure Scholarship Information Sheet

The Section G16 OA High Adventure Scholarship was created to provide monetary support to Arrowmen within the section to participate in an Order of the Arrow High Adventure (OAHA) program.

OA High Adventure is an experience unlike any other found in Scouting and the Order of the Arrow. Section G16 strongly encourages Arrowmen to take advantage of the opportunity by providing financial assistance for Arrowmen in Lo La'Qam Geela, Tsisqan, and Wauna La-Mon'tay Lodges who participate in OAHA programs.

The Section G16 OA High Adventure Scholarship is reserved for those individuals who exhibit service as well as a future commitment to the Order of the Arrow in the section and their home lodge. It is expected of the recipients that they continue their service in the OA as well as bring the enthusiasm gained from these programs back to their home councils, lodges, chapters, and units. Each recipient will be required at the end of their experience to provide the section with an account of their experiences that can be posted on the section website for recognition and promotion of the programs and the scholarship.

The minimum amount awarded to recipients will be \$100. This amount may be increased depending on the cost of the program attended and the need of the applicant. The amount awarded will not exceed the cost of the program. Scholarship funding will only be applied to the program fee. Participants will be responsible for their own transportation. The Key 3 (section chief, section adviser, and section staff adviser) will determine the committee that will select the recipients each year.

Requirements to be considered for the scholarship:

- 1. Must have attended the Section G16 Conclave in the year prior to the selected OAHA program.
- 2. Must be a member in good standing with a lodge in Section G16
- 3. Must have approval from their lodge adviser
- 4. Must have approval from their council Scout executive or their designee
- 5. Must meet all requirements for the selected OAHA program.

Applications must be submitted no later January 31st each year. Applicants will be notified of their selection no later than March 1st. Scholarships will be sent to the applicant's lodge. Lodges are encouraged to assist their Arrowmen in applying for their OAHA program. In the event the applicant does not attend the OAHA program, the scholarship must be returned to the section.
