The following shooting sports programs are offered at Camp Baker. A Scout must have an affirmative signed permission form on file in order to participate in shooting sports. Please check and initial the boxes of each program your child has your permission to participate in.

Archery

Archery not offered at conclave

Youth participants will be instructed how to handle, maintain, and shoot arrows safely and be provided instruction to increase their shooting skills. Youth participants will have classroom and range instruction in which they will shoot under the supervision of a trained USA Archery Level 1 or higher certified Archery Instructor. All participants will be required to wear protective gear, including armguards and finger tabs, while on the range.

Rifle & Black Powder Rifle

Rifle & Black Powder not offered at conclave

Youth participants will be instructed how to handle, maintain, and shoot a rifle or black powder rifle safely and be provided instruction to develop/increase their shooting skills. Youth participants will have classroom and range instruction where they will fire a rifle or black powder rifle under the supervision of a trained NRA Range Safety Officer and NRA Certified rifle/black powder rifle instructor. All participants will be required to wear eye and ear protection while on the range.

Cowboy Action Shooting 🛛 Yes 🗆 No _____ initial

Scouts aged 14 and above (or 13 and completed eighth grade) will be introduced to the sport of Cowboy Action Shooting (CAS) and will be instructed how to safely handle and shoot a pistol, rifle, and a shotgun. The CAS program will be operated under the supervision of an NRA Range Safety Officer and NRA Certified Instructors for the firearms used. All participants will be required to wear eye and ear protection while on the range.

For safety, my child and I agree they will do the following:

- Complete and comply with the range training.
- Wear all the required safety gear while on the range.
- Always follow range officer instructions.
- Handle firearms or archery equipment ONLY AFTER instructed and given permission by the instructors and range officers.

Permission to use the range may be denied if a Scout does not follow all safety instructions given by the Shooting Sports staff. In that case, the remaining participation fee is forfeited.
